KITCHEN WORKSHOP

Learners are taught to butter bread and use various types of spread to make sandwiches. They cut the sandwiches into the required sizes and some learners will pack the correct amount of sandwiches per class. They are taught to clean their work surface and tidy the kitchen.

The learners wipe the tables and chairs in the hostel's dining room, dust, sweep and mop the floors of the dining room.

CARWASH WORKSHOP

Learners are taught to dust and vacuum a car on the inside. They are taught to hose down the car and wash and dry it afterwards.

LAUNDRY WORKSHOP

Learners learn to sort and fold various types of washing in the laundry.

GARDENING WORKSHOP

The learners are taught to use basic gardening equipment. They are taught the basic skills e.g. to rake, weed and plant vegetables in a pot or small vegetable patch.

PORTERS

Certain learners act as porters by transporting wheelchair-bound learners to and from the therapy rooms. They work under the supervision of the Therapist and conduct basic cleaning and sorting tasks while the therapist is busy with a session.

STAFFROOM CLEANING

Learners are taught to do basic cleaning tasks e.g. cleaning tables, washing dishes, dusting, sweeping and mopping.

COFFEE SHOP

On Wednesdays, the learners work in the Coffee Shop. They take orders from the other learners, prepare the tea and coffee and serve the learners. They are also taught to do basic cleaning tasks e.g. cleaning tables, washing dishes, dusting, sweeping and mopping. Prior to the Wednesday they are involved in the preparation of the food to be served on the Wednesday, as well as being taught the financial and purchasing which goes into the running of a coffee shop. This pre-preparation in the days prior to the Wednesday includes other senior learners who are not yet in the formal school- to- work program.
